## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entry eligibility is at the discretion of show management.
- Riders and horses must pre-enter by **March 26, 2026**. A \$30 late fee per horse applies after March 26.
- All riders must sign a "hold harmless release" and leave a signed blank check at the Secretary's stand to receive a number.
- Proof of current Coggins and vaccinations must be presented at check-in.
- No scratches after class begins.
- Foxhunters, Junior Foxhunters, Junior Hilltoppers, and Hilltoppers must have a letter of qualification from the Master of their hunt, stating that the horse and rider combination has been out hunting three times this season in comparable flights. The qualification form is in the Prize List and is available on the Aiken Horse Show website: [www.aikenhorseshow.org/letter of qualification](http://www.aikenhorseshow.org/letter of qualification).
- **Protective headgear is mandatory at all times when mounted.** Riders must have a properly fitted ASTM-SEI approved helmet. Top hats and bowlers are not permitted.
- Proper attire is required for all classes. Braiding is appreciated.
- Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle classes.
- Anyone paid to ride, exercise, or instruct is not eligible to compete in the Amateur Divisions.
- Classes may be split, combined, or cancelled at the discretion of show management.
- Each obstacle will have a high and a low side. All entries in the **Foxhunter Division must jump the high side.**
- The dotted line may be enforced; please refer to course diagrams.
- No horse or pony may be tied to the ring railing.
- No vans or trailers are permitted in the Woods.
- Any rider found schooling in the ring after March 1st will be disqualified.
- All horses must be serviceably sound and may be required to jog for soundness.

### Point Calculations

- Championships will be awarded in divisions with three or more entries using the following tabulation: 1st- 10 points, 2nd- 6 points, 3rd- 4 points, 4th- 2 points, 5th- 1 point, 6th- 1/2 point.
- Only the top four horses/riders over fences will be eligible for under saddle points.
- The horse and rider combination with the highest total points will be Champion; the second highest will be Reserve Champion.
- In the event of a tie, the horse and rider combination with the highest number of points over fences will be declared Champion.
- \* Aiken Saddlery Grand Champion of the Day will be awarded to the horse/rider combination with the highest number of points in a single, three-class division that includes over fences classes. In the event of a tie, the rider with the most points over fences will be Champion.
- \* Hunter OTTB High Point will be awarded to the OTTB with the most points for the day.
- \* Foxhunter OTTB High Point will be awarded to the OTTB with the most points for the day.
- \* Leading Open Rider — Rider with the most points in the Open Division.
- \* Leading Amateur Rider — Rider with the most points in the Amateur Division.
- \* Future Hunter Classic — Rider's first course score and classic score are added together for placing.

**NO DOGS** permitted in the tent.

**ALL DOGS** on the show grounds **must be leashed** and cannot be left unattended.




